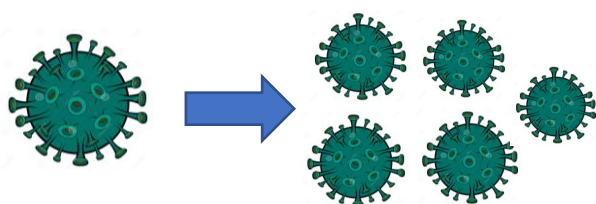


Coronavirus Local Lockdown

Things that have changed:



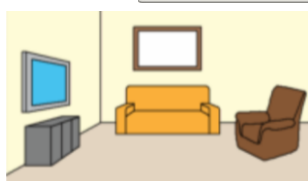
Cafés, restaurants and pubs have to close.

You can still do activities at home.



You can still go outside to exercise, keeping 2 metres social distance.



When you go out, please wear a face covering if you can.



Wash your hands with soap for 20 seconds.
