Lockdown Rules:

Earlier this week the Government told us that the plan to end lockdown would **not** happen on the 21st June.



This has been changed to the **19th July**.

This is because the number of people catching Coronavirus is going up.



Also, the number of people going into hospital with Coronavirus is going up.



Most people in hospital with Coronavirus have not had the vaccine or have only had one dose of the vaccine.

People working in care homes



The Government is planning to make it a rule that everyone who works in a care home that is registered with the Care Quality Commission (CQC) has to have both doses of the vaccine.



This includes care staff, volunteers, hairdressers, trades people and care inspectors.



This will only happen if most Members of Parliament agree. It could start in October.

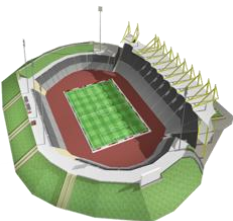


The Government will ask people if they think that everyone who works for the National Health Service (NHS) should also have to have the vaccine.
