Who is Inclusion North:

Inclusion North exists to make inclusion real for all people with a learning disability and autism.

We do this by working with people with a learning disability, autism, family carers and organisations that support them.



Our work:

We work to change society so that everybody with a learning disability and autism can live as full, active, and equal citizens.

This means changing the way people think, and the way things are done.



About the involvement leaders roles we have:

These roles are for people and families with lived experience of using specialist hospital services, like assessment and treatment units or secure services.

This might mean you are in hospital now or have been in the past.

We want to work with people with a learning disability, autistic people, young people and family carers.

We will need you to use your lived experience to help others to have a voice and to plan and deliver good services, and to improve the way things are done.



About the Involvement leaders role you will do and the pay you will get:

We can pay you up to 3 hours per week and you get paid for your involvement £10 per hour.

You will be part of a bigger team working together across the region to do the same role - we are hoping

to have 10 people.

You will get some training and support at the start to learn about the role.

You will get help to do the role from a member of staff at Inclusion North

The involvement leader role is to:

- Share your experiences about being in hospital
- Learn new skills about speaking up
- Become a local leader for change
- Listen to other people's experiences
- Collect everyone's views and help make sense of what people what to see change
- Share information with the people who manage and buy services

Important:

We do not need to know why you are in hospital or anything about your past unless that is really needed to keep people safe.
