People will be given an involvement fee of £10 per hour for their time.

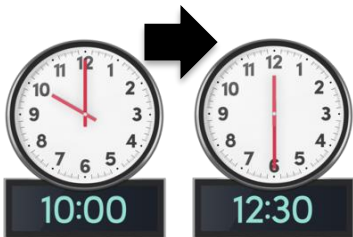


What skills, knowledge and experience do you need to be involved?
