- To make any necessary travel bookings at the Expert Adviser's request.

The Supporter will need to be able to support the Expert Adviser at virtual Care (Education) and Treatment Reviews currently held through Microsoft Teams.

As and when the COVID 19 pandemic is over and Care (Education) and Treatment reviews return to face to face, the Supporter will be required to accompany the Expert Adviser to the review.

Supporters are paid £20.00 per hour and each Care (Education) and Treatment Review lasts for around 7 hours. (This includes an element of holiday pay)

The Supporter's role is a casual contract.
