How we made our promise to take action to stop climate change



1. In the summer of 2021, we worked with a student who ran an accessible workshop about climate change for our staff, Directors and Advisory Council



2. At that workshop, some people volunteered to form our Take Action to Stop Climate Change group



3. That group meets once a month and they came up with some ideas

We decided there are 3 big things we can do



1. Change how we run Inclusion North to make sure we do what we can to stop climate change



2. Influence other people who are more powerful, to do more to stop climate change



3. Make sure people with a learning disability and autistic people are included in the campaign to stop climate change



But before we could start work on this, there was something we had to do...



We had to learn more about climate change so we understand what it means and how to stop it

So our climate change action plan for 2022 is



1. Do some training so we understand more about climate change and how to stop it



2. Make this training accessible for all people with a learning disability and autistic people



3. Look at how we run Inclusion North and make a plan to change things that are bad for the environment



4. Make a list of who we know that has more power than us to stop climate change. Make a plan to talk to them and ask them to do more
