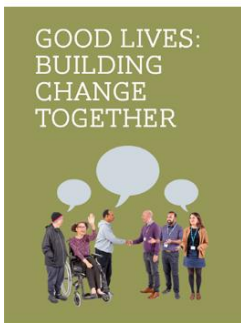
Learning Disability England - Good Lives Framework

The quality of our lives is always affected by Government Policy. The current Government Policy is making it difficult for people to live on the amount of money they have got.



For people with a learning disability, autistic people and family carers it can often be much worse.

Inclusion North is sharing the Good Lives Framework across lots of areas to try and improve the quality of people's lives.



The Good Lives Framework is linked to Human Rights and at the moment includes six different areas: More areas will be added.

1. Getting the right support
2. Having the home we want to have
3. Self-advocacy and advocacy
4. Communication and staying connected
5. To love and be loved
6. Contribution and paid work
