Sadly, on the 8th September 2022 Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II died.

The Queen was 96 years old and had been the Queen of our country for 70 years.



King Charles III is now the King of England.

The Queen's funeral will be on Monday 19th September at 11am at Westminster Abbey in London.
