

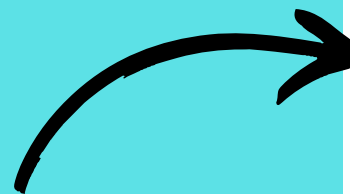
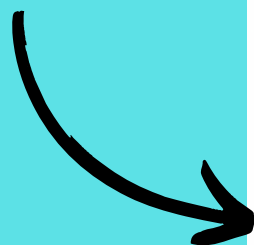

Please keep your language respectful.

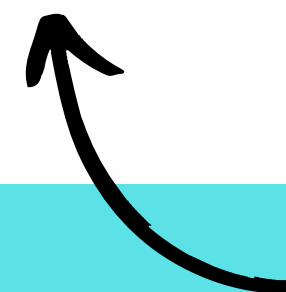
