A new project in the Harrogate and Rural area



Inclusion North is working with Harrogate Skills 4 Living Centre to find out what people think a good life looks like for people with learning disabilities and autistic people living in the area.

This new project is funded by the Lottery Community Fund.



The project aims to:



- ✓ Better understand the needs of local people who have learning disabilities or who are autistic people.
- ✓ Provide ideas for future co-production and co-design of support and services
- ✓ Help services to work together and be better connected.





The project has a steering group made up of people with lived experience who will oversee the project until early in 2023.



We would like people with lived experience to be involved in telling us what they think a good life looks like for them in the Harrogate and Rural area?



This includes:

- People with a learning disability
- Autistic people
- Family carers



We will be holding two meetings in November to find out what people think. One will be a zoom meeting and one face-to-face in Harrogate.



If you would like to come to one of our friendly meetings and tell us what you think about a good life, please choose which meeting suits you best and book your place. Contact details are on the next page.

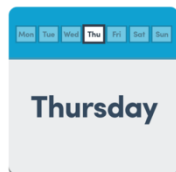
