What does the North East and Yorkshire Region Programme Learning Disability and Autism Programme Board do?

The Programme Board meets four times a year.

They work together so that people with a learning disability and autistic people can have happy and healthy lives.



The Experts by Experience job in the meetings is to share information about what important things are happening across the West Yorkshire area.

The Big Board meetings happen four times a year. There are also other meetings which include:

- pre-planning meetings
- meetings after the Big Board meeting



Meeting 1 – (1.5 hours)

A planning meeting with someone from the West Yorkshire Transforming Care Partnership.

They will tell you about the work that is happening across the area.



Meeting 2 - (1 hour)

A pre-meeting with other experts that are members of the North East and Yorkshire Region Learning Disability and Autism Programme Board.



Meeting 3 – (2 hours)

The big meeting for the North East and Yorkshire Regions Learning Disability and Autism Programme Board.



Meeting 4 -

To talk about and to share what happened, what worked well in the big meeting. (1 hour)



The Experts by Experience must be able to take part in all the meetings.

This means they can be involved in:

- planning
- preparing
- sharing

Inclusion North will be supporting you at all of these meetings.

You can choose to be paid for your involvement but this is not paid employment.

You can receive an involvement payment of £20.00 per hour

Or

You can also choose to do the role on as a volunteer.

Or

You can choose to give your involvement payment to a charity of your choice.
