Inclusion North will share an important news story and tell you about their own work here every two weeks.



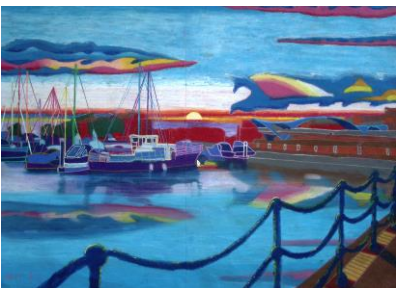
In this week's news I want to share with you some amazing art work, that has been created by learners at Case Training in Hull.
