Sheffield Voices have shared some information about the government who are testing an emergency alert on 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2023. This alert will be sent to people's mobile phones at 3pm.

An emergency alert is to let people know if there is a life threatening emergency nearby.

This is not a real alert on **23<sup>rd</sup> April** and is just a test.

You can turn off emergency alerts on your phone if you do not want to receive them.

To turn off emergency alerts on your mobile phone you need to:

- Find emergency alerts in your settings
- Turn off settings for severe alerts and extreme alerts
- If this does not work, or you cannot find where
  your settings are, call the helpline for the mobile
  phone you have or take your mobile into a phone
  shop.
