Reasonable Adjustments Flag



Inclusion North is supporting the North East and Cumbria Learning Disability Network to raise awareness about reasonable adjustments for disabled people in health and social care services.



We are working with lots of different organisations to collect the views and experiences of autistic people, people with a learning disability, and parents/carers.



We have started by asking people what they know about reasonable adjustments and how to ask for them.



Some people have told us that it is easier for them if professionals ask about reasonable adjustments and give examples.



Many people told us they didn't know how to ask for reasonable adjustments or said it was hard to ask.



We hope that this work will make it easier for disabled people to get the support they need when using health and social care services.
