If you want to vote at a Polling Station you must have photo ID. This is a new rule this year.



If you do not have a photo ID you can apply for one. The deadline to apply for photo ID is 5pm on 24th April 2024.

Voter ID



If you want to vote at a polling station you must show ID before you vote.



You will not be able to vote if you do not show your ID.



You only need to take 1 of any of these kinds of ID:

- ✓ Passport
- ✓ Driving Licence
- ✓ Blue Parking Bage
- ✓ Bus Pass
- ✓ Identity card with a proof of age hologram
- ✓ Other government identity card



If you do not have any of these kinds of ID, you can apply for a free voter ID document. This is called a **Voter Authority Certificate**.



You have to fill in a form to be able to get a **Voter Authority Certificate**.

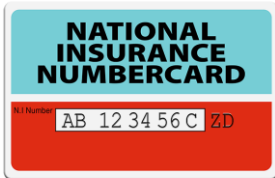
