The Reasonable Adjustment Flag will help to make sure that disabled people get the support they need.

Making a Video



We want to make a video.



The video will help people understand the Reasonable Adjustment Flag.



The video will help people to know their rights about getting reasonable adjustments.

Experts by Experience



We are looking for **5 experts by experience** to help us plan and make the video.



Experts need to live in the North East or North Cumbria.

Diversity is important to us



We want the video to show the different kinds of support that people need.

We need help from people with different disabilities.



This includes people with a learning disability and autistic people.



It also includes people with a physical disability, people who use a wheelchair, or people with hearing or vision differences.



We would love to have help from disabled people who are from different ethnic or racial groups.



We would love to have help from disabled people who have different gender identity. This might be people who are **non-binary** or **transgender**.



Transgender people feel that the body they were born into is not right for them. This means they may want to change from being a man to a woman, or from a woman to a man.



Non-binary people feel that the description of being either a man or a woman is not right for them. This means they may want to describe themselves as either a man, a woman or something else.

How will the planning meetings work?



You would be invited to come to 4 meetings with Inclusion North, to plan the video together.



The planning meetings will be online. Each meeting will be up to 2 hours long.



We would choose a day and time that works for everyone.

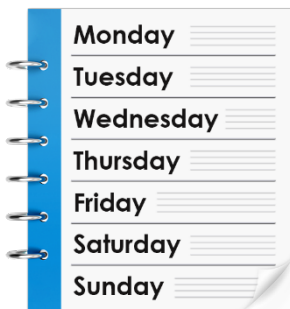
How will the filming work?



You will be invited to come and be filmed for the video. The filming will be in person.



We don't know where the video will be filmed yet. It might be somewhere like a doctor's surgery.



We don't know how long the filming will take. It might take two full days, or it might be less.



We will plan the details of the video and the filming, together in our planning meetings.



We will make sure everyone knows what is happening, and that the plans work for everyone.

Who will see the video?



When we have a video that everyone is happy with, it will be shared with lots of people.



It will be shared on social media. It will be put on websites.



It will be emailed to people.



It will be a public video that anyone can watch.

You can bring a support person to meetings with you, if you want to.



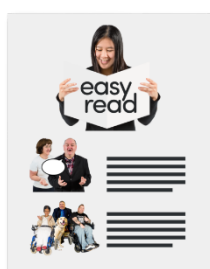
We will choose accessible places for the filming days.
