



This is what our Board of Directors does:

1. Run the Company well - making sure Inclusion North follows Company Law and the rules we make for ourselves.



2. Manage the money – making sure that Inclusion North have enough money and spend it the right way



3. Check the work we do – making sure it is good quality and fits with our values



4. Support the Chief Executive – helping them to manage the staff team and develop the company



5. Think about the future – planning ahead to make sure Inclusion North does work that is important to people with a learning disability, autistic people and their families



6. Make sure people know about Inclusion North – sharing information with other people and organisations

The Law says that Directors have to be at least 18 years old.



We can have 10 Directors on the Board. Inclusion North Staff cannot be Directors.



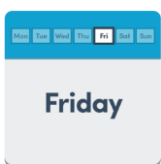
We have 2 Co Chairs.

One Co Chair has a learning disability or is autistic. The other Co Chair is a professional or family carer.



There are 6 Directors meetings every year.

They are usually on a Friday afternoon and last 2 hours.



We have most of our meetings in York but you can join online if you are not able to travel to the meeting. It is important that directors try their best to meet face to face for director's meetings.



There is also 2 meetings every year when the Directors meet with the Advisory Council and the staff team.
