Learning Disability week starts Monday 16th June until Sunday 22nd June.

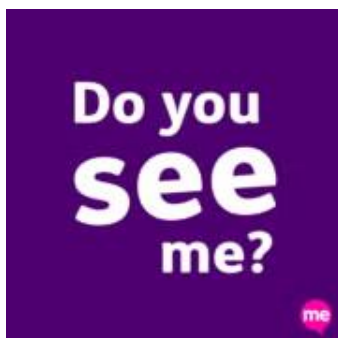
The annual event raises awareness about different types of learning disability.
