This project is called "Swept Under the Carpet" Lets Talk about sex, periods and having Babies.



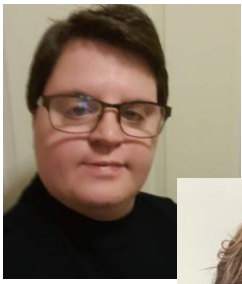
People with a learning disability sometimes don't get the chance to get good information or to have conversations about sex, periods and having babies.
