Reasonable Adjustments Digital Flag Video



Reasonable adjustments are changes made to help disabled people access health and care services.



The Reasonable Adjustment Digital Flag is a computer tool. It helps to record people's reasonable adjustments.



The Reasonable Adjustment Digital Flag is important for health and social care.



It will help to make sure that disabled people get the support they need.



Inclusion North set up a group of lived-experience experts to co-produce a video about the Reasonable Adjustments Digital Flag.

The experts in the group had different disabilities and lived-experience, including:

- using a wheelchair
- having a learning disability
- being blind
- being deaf
- being autistic
- being the parent of someone with a profound and multiple learning disability.



We filmed the video at the Northumbria Health and Care Academy. It has a pretend doctor's room, a pretend hospital ward, and a pretend flat. We used all these spaces for filming.



The video will help people to understand their rights about reasonable adjustments and the Reasonable Adjustment Digital Flag. We will share the video when it is finished.
