Have your say on the Accessibility Act.

Disability Rights UK thinks there should be a new law called the Accessibility Act.

What the Accessibility Act could do.

The Accessibility Act would be about making things:

- Easier to use.
- Easier to understand.
- Fairer for everyone.



This could include buildings, services, websites, transport and information.

What is happening now.

Disability Rights UK want to hear from Autistic people and people with a learning disability about what needs to change.



This is called a **consultation**.

The consultation includes a survey.

Why your voice matters.

- You know what helps you.
- You know what makes life harder.





What the survey asks.

The survey asks questions about:

- What accessibility means to you.
- What problems you face.
- What changes you want
- What support you need.



There are no right or wrong answers.

You can skip any question you do not want to answer.

You can do the survey on your own or with someone you trust.
